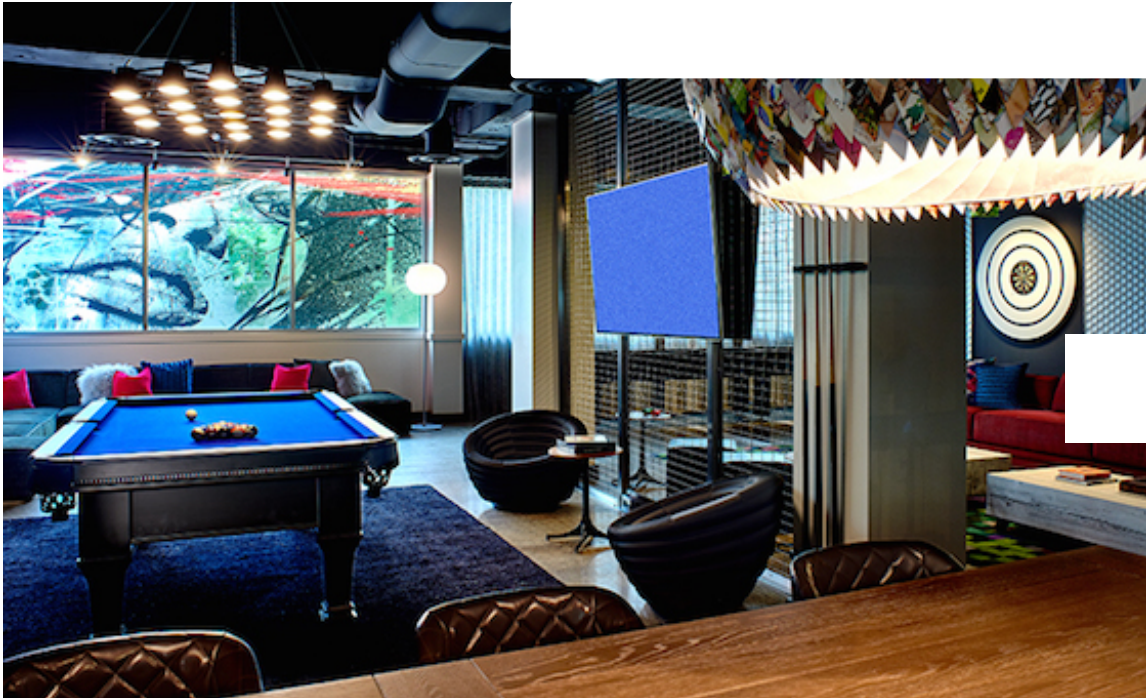
The Colosseum at Hotel Modera was designed to be artistic and playful.

The Colosseum includes a pool table, shuffleboard, full size Connect-4, and vertical corn hole. The space

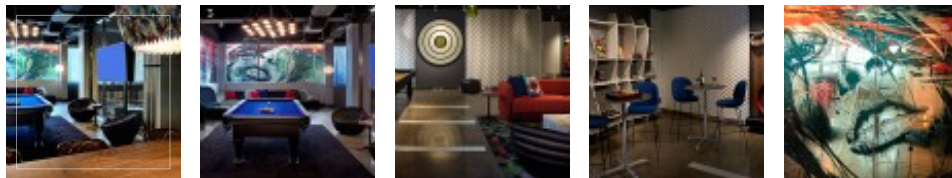

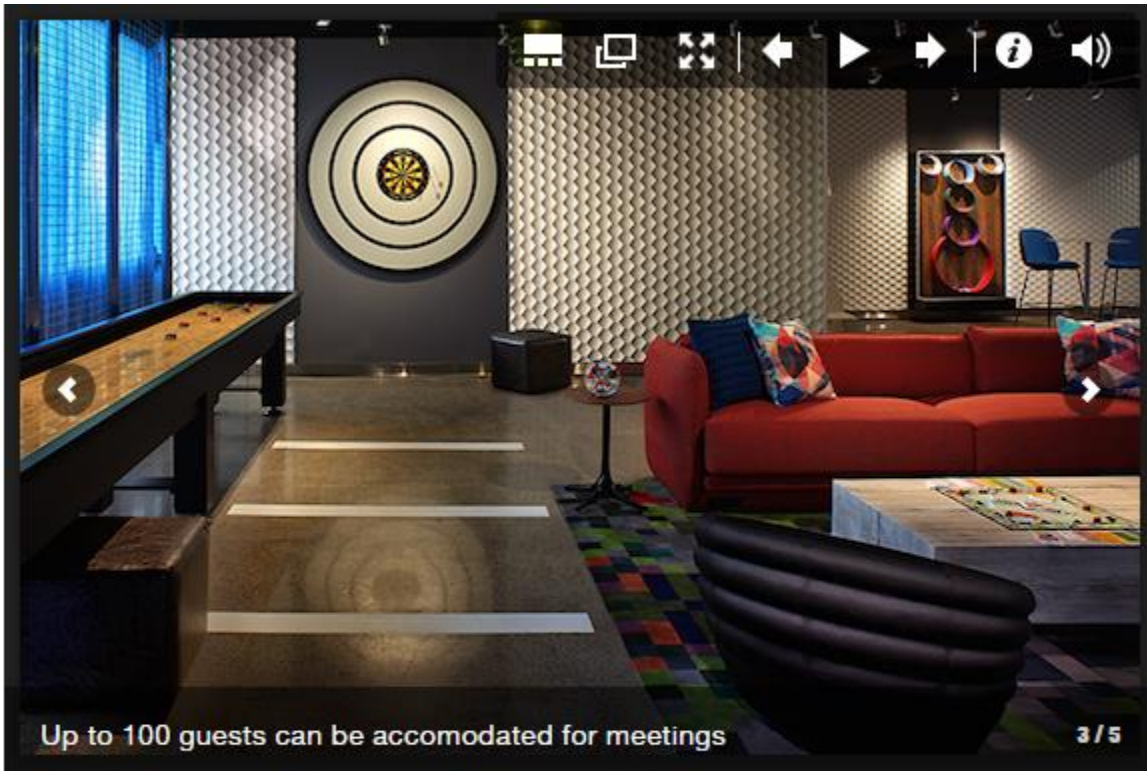


The Colosseum includes a pool table, shuffleboard, full size Connect-4, and vertical corn hole. 1 / 5
